SCHEMES FOR INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT & EMPLOYMENT GENERATION.

1. INDUSTRIAL PROMOTION SUBSIDY SCHEME : Govt. of Maharashtra is one of the first States implementing Package Scheme of Incentives for decentralisation of industries. Scheme is proven as most effective for indl. decentralisation. Govt. involves the the Chamber of Commerce & Industries, Indl.Organisations while framing the policies. Govt. has simplified the procedural Rule & Regulations while framing the policy and classified whole State in 6 categories like A,B,C,D,D+ & No Industry Dist. as per the Indl.development so far achieved.

Latur dist. is categorised as D+ zone and eligible upto 50% and 30% subsidy against the total fixed capital investment, done by the Micro/Small & Medium/Large Scale units respectively. Besides this, other incentives like Stamp duty/Electricity duty exemption, Royalty refund, Interest subsidy for Textiles. Special incentives for quality upgradation are also admissible. Scheme is effective from 1.4.07 to 31.3.2011.

2. SEED MONEY SCHEME : To encourage self employment venture amongst unemployed youths, Govt. has specially announced New Seed Money Scheme w.e.f.18.5.07 increasing project cost limit from Rs.10 lakhs to 25 lakhs, reducing rate of interest on seed capital from 10% to 6%. A special rebate of 3% is admissible for regular repayment of seed capital.

Eligible educated unemployed gets 15% soft loan from DIC @ 6% as seed money loan for the project cost upto Rs.25 lakhs and the upper limit of seed money Rs.3.75 lakhs. In the interest of social justice, for all ackward categories and handicapped youths, 20% seed money loan is eligible for the project cost upto Rs.10 lakhs.

Eligibility :

1. Age limit - 18 to 50 years.
2. Minimum 7th Std. pass.
3. Domicile of Maharashtra State.

3. DIC Margin Money Scheme:

1. Any rural service and cottage industry is eligible to get the benefit under the scheme.
2. Soft loan from DIC for general categories 20% upto Rs.40,000/- and 30% for the SC/ST category upto Rs.60,000/- against the project cost approved by the Financial Institutions.
3. The value of Plant & Machinery should not be more than Rs.2.lakhs.Soft loan is admissible @ 4% interest p.a.

4. NABARD MARGIN MONEY SCHEME :

1. Any rural small scale industry.
2. Maximum Project cost upto 25 lakhs.
3. 20% Interest free loan from NABARD with service charges.

Elegibility :

1. Special high-tech projects are eligible only .
2. All nationalised and schedule commercial banks are eligible for finance.

5. **Khadi Gramodyog Margin Money Scheme for Rural Sector :**

To encourage rural industrialisation in micro, small and service sector as well as employment generation, under this scheme, financial assistance is eligible as under :

Note : Margin Money is interest free loan. If bank loan repayment is regular, Margin money amount will be converted into subsidy automatically.

6. **Prime Minister Rojgar Yojana :**

For the eradication of unemployment , on 15th August 1993 i.e. on the 47th Independence Day of India, Hon'ble Prime Minister of India declared this scheme. This scheme has been enforced by name Prime Minister Rojgar Yojana (PMRY) from 2nd October 1993.

1. Project cost upto Rs.2 lakhs for Business & Service Industry.
2. Project cost upto Rs.5 lakhs for Industry .
3. Maximum Quantum of Subsidy is 15% of th Project cost with a ceiling of Rs.12500 for SHG, quantum of subsidy is upto Rs.15000/- for each beneficiery with a ceiling of Rs.1.25 lakhs.

Eligibility :

1. Minimum 8th Std.Pass.
2. Age 18 to 35 yrs .(For SC/ST/Woman/PH/Ex-serviceman 18- 45 yrs.)
3. Family Annual Income should not more than Rs.1.00 lakh.
4. Resident of district at least 3 years.

7. ENTREPRENEURSHIP DEVELOPMENT TRAINING PROGRAMME :

Under this scheme, youths are given motivational inputs of entrepreneurial skills . Recently, Govt.of Maharashtra has decided to impart need based training free of cost for all categories of youths in various trades upto one to two months duration.

8. District Award to Entrepreneurs :

DIC is implementing this scheme since 1985 for micro & small entrepreneurs for motivation. Award is honoured to the unit for quality production , best management, employment generation and welfare, etc. The micro & small scale industries who have permanently registered with Directorate of Industries at least prior to 3 years and is engaged in continuous production for the last 2 yrs., such industries can become eligible for this scheme.

The award of First Prize is Rs. Fifteen thousand , Silver Momento as a Mark of Honour. and Second Award is Rs Ten thousand with Silver Momento as a Mark of Honour. The Selection Committee is headed by the Hon'ble District Collector.

9. **ZILLA UDYOG MITRA:**This is the Committee headed by the Dist.Collector to sort out various problems & difficulties of indl.units. Committee consists of Officers related to industrial development as well as Industries Associations.
